Congratulations on joining the RAJE Madrichim Program Spring semester 2009!

Madrichim Advanced Leadership Fellowship is a second level program for talented students and young professionals with leadership potential, who are looking to make a real difference for the Jewish people.

The program goals are:

- Empower participants with leadership skills to lead RAJE Europe Israel Trips.
- Explore your Jewish identity and take on a leadership role within the RAJE community.

Program Overview

1. Ten study sessions:

The study sessions will be held on Sundays from 3:30 – 8:00 PM and will feature:

- Judaism A-Z: Each session includes a comprehensive survey of a topic in Jewish life or thought
- Adventures in Jewish law and tradition: a hands-on exploration of practical Judaism
- An exploration of core Jewish texts
- Intense training of leadership skills.

2. Two In-House Shabbat experience at the RAJE Center

Point Distribution:

- 1 hour of session =1 point.
- Shabbat=10-15 points each.
- Presentation= 5-10 point.
- Team building assignment=5-10 points.
- Volunteer hour=1 point each.
- Evaluation bonus=0-25 points.
- Project=0-5 points each.

Accumulation of Points:

- **100** points allows program graduate to lead summer 2009 RAJE Europe/Israel trip as a madrich.
- \$599 Cash deposit, refundable immediately after the trip
- **70-99** points: allows graduating student to participate on summer 2009 RAJE Europe/Israel trip,
- FREE for full-time college students and \$299 for non-full time students with completion of an additional semester of Madrich program, Heritage level 2 or Talmud/Tanach Program.
- \$299 for full-time college students and \$599 for non-full time students with completion of 1 semester.
- **52 -69** points: allows graduating student to participate on summer 2009 Raje Europe/Israel trip, basic program completion applicable (link to heritage program rules)
- \$599 for full-time college students and \$799 for non-full time students

Obtaining less than 52 points deems participant ineligible for the trip

* Paris and London trips have additional \$200 non refundable surcharge

Program Dates:

Sessions:

February 22nd, March 1st, March 8th, March 15th, March 22nd,
March 29th, April 5th, April 19th, April 26th, May 3rd

Program rules:

- Weekly on time attendance and participation in Sunday sessions 3:30-8:30 PM.
Missing more than two sessions disqualifies a student from program completion. Showing up late to a session counts as absence.
- Upon the completion of each Sunday session a program evaluation form must be completed and submitted online prior to the following Sunday session
- To Organize and lead a minimum of two Shabbatons @ RAJE center

4. Europe – Israel Trip:

**Paris-Israel Trip: May 31st – June 16th — *FREE Extension*
(\$200 of \$999 is a surcharge and is NOT refundable)**

**London – Israel: May 31st – June 16th — *FREE Extension*
(\$200 of \$999 is a surcharge and is NOT refundable)**

**Israel Heritage Trip: June 14th-June 29th
*FREE Extension***

**Israel Full Throttle Trip: June 14th-June 29th
*FREE Extension***

Vienna-Israel Trip: June 28th –July 14th

Copy of passport must be submitted with the deposit.

Spots for these trips are limited and are available on a first come-first serve basis (pending completion of the program requirements). In order to reserve your spot a deposit must be submitted by March 15th, 2009.

All deposits are non-refundable after due date submission and cannot be transferred if the student misses the trip for whatever reason. All students who do not participate in the trip during the summer season are eligible for a similar trip during the subsequent winter season provided that such a trip is offered by the organization and subject to all subsequent rules & pricing changes. Participation on trips is subject to program completion and deposits.

The portion of the deposit due to the student for program completion will be returned during the next semester at the graduation ceremony. Program completion on either a 'basic' or 'advanced' level is necessary to be eligible for the trip. RAJE staff reserves the right to determine eligibility of a participant (despite completion of the program requirements) based on various factors such as disruptive conduct during all aspects of the program, including Shabbat, as well as falsifying any information or documents and the like.
